**WHO** The Buckeye Trail Association in cooperation with the North Country Trail Association, American Discovery Trail Society, Wayne National Forest, Little Cities of the Forest Collaborative, Sunday Creek Watershed Group, and Burr Oak State Park

**WHAT** 5 hiking challenges consisting of 20 (day & night), 40, 60, and 80 miles that need to be completed in 12, 24, 36, and 48 hours respectively

**WHEN** Thursday, June 21st at 12pm–Sunday, June 24th at 12pm

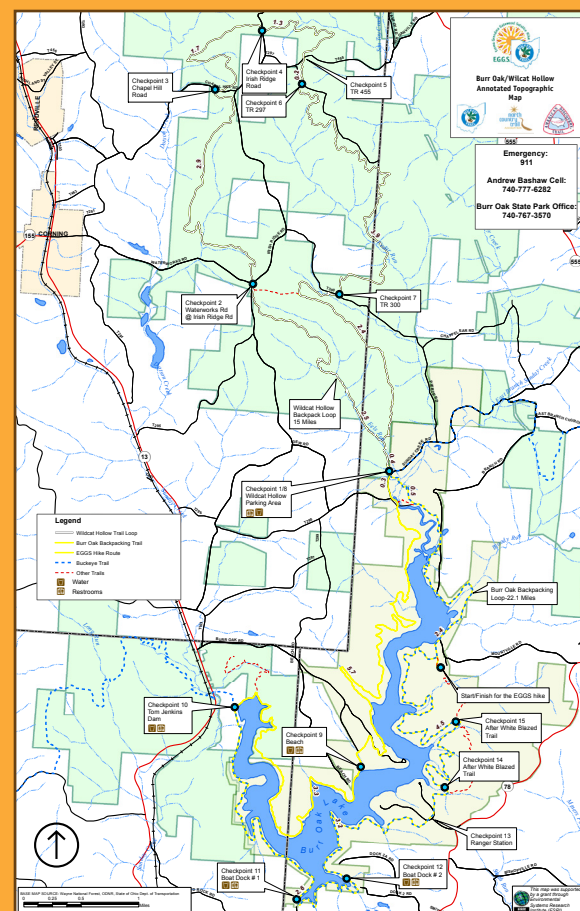
**WHERE** Burr Oak State Park and Wildcat Hollow Backpack Trails

**WHY** To honor a founding member of the BTA and the first female to thru-hike the Appalachian Trail, Emma “Grandma” Gatewood, an Ohio native and long time advocate of ultra-light backpacking

**VOLUNTEERS** We will be looking for volunteers to man trail checkpoints, assist with registration, and help with camping activities for any hikers bringing their family and little hikers to the event. Volunteers receive free meals from the BTA Chuckwagon and a free t-shirt.

**COST** Registration on-line: Individual - \$50
